The Problem We Address

Traditional shelters and transitional housing often fail to meet deep human needs for belonging, purpose, and identity. Heyoka Fire exists to restore dignity through sacred development and structured community.

The Heyoka Fire Sanctuary Model

Our sanctuary housing model is faith-rooted, culturally intentional, and grounded in trauma-informed care. Core pillars include:

- Identity Formation
- Structured Living
- Trauma-Informed Practices
- Faith as Foundation
- Community Integration

Who We Serve

We serve elderly unhoused adults, people exiting addiction, individuals experiencing crisis, and vulnerable youth. We focus on populations often overlooked by traditional systems.

Outcomes & Impact

Residents experience stabilization, self-respect, relapse reduction, community engagement, and identity restoration. Our work centers long-term transformation, not temporary shelter.
